

Spring will be here soon and CWCC is going to be a busy place with all of the course improvements going on. The pond has been expanded from a 3 million gallon holding capacity to 8 million and should help greatly with our water shortage. The material from the pond was used to fill in the right side of hole nine's landing area. We also used the material to create a large white tee on hole eight. Other tees that were built this winter include tripling the size of the white tee on hole three, a new white tee on hole 15 and a new red tee on hole 15. The driving range is also getting a makeover with huge elevated target greens.
